Sub: Designation of State Agency/ State RPO Monitoring Agency/ Agencies in accordance with provisions under Regulation 14 of Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Cogeneration and Generation of Electricity from Renewable Sources of Energy), (Revision-II), Regulations, 2021

ORDER

(Date of Order: 12.03.2025)

1. Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Cogeneration and Generation of Electricity from Renewable Sources of Energy), (Revision-11), Regulations, 2021, have been notified in the Gazette of Madhya Pradesh on 12th November' 2021. The said regulation has been amended from time to time.
2. As per provision under 2(xxiii) and 2 (xxii) (a) read with Regulation 14 of the aforesaid Regulations, the Commission has to designate a State Agency and State RPO Monitoring Agency / Agencies. The functions of such State Agency and State RPO Monitoring Agency / Agencies are provided in Regulation 14 of aforesaid Regulations, 2021.
3. In accordance with Regulation 14 (A) of the aforesaid Regulations, Madhya Pradesh Urja Vikas Nigam Ltd. is hereby designated as the State Agency by the Commission to perform functions provided under the aforesaid regulations, other than those provided in Regulation 14(B) of the aforesaid Regulations.
4. In accordance with Regulation 14 (B) of the aforesaid Regulations, Madhya Pradesh Poorv Kshetra Vidyut Vitaran Company Limited, Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh Paschim Kshetra Vidyut Vitaran Company Limited, Indore and Madhya Pradesh Madhya Kshetra Vidyut Vitaran Company Limited, Bhopal are hereby designated as the State RPO Monitoring Agencies by the Commission to monitor, verify and submit to the Commission RPO compliance report of each obligated entity in their respective licensed area.
5. In accordance with Regulation 14 (B) of the aforesaid Regulations, Madhya Pradesh State Load Despatch Center, Jabalpur is hereby designated as the State RPO Monitoring Agency by the Commission to monitor, verify and submit to the Commission RPO compliance report of State Distribution Companies/ Other Distribution Licensees like MPUVNL etc.
6. The Commission hereby authorises the State RPO Monitoring Agency/ Agencies for collection of information related to RPO compliance from various sources such as Renewable Energy Generating Companies, Obligated Entities, SLDC, etc. For discharging the aforesaid function State RPO Monitoring Agency/ Agencies shall be guided by the protocol as may be approved by the Commission.
7. The State RPO Monitoring Agency/ Agencies shall register themselves on the RPO Web portal namely <https://mperc.in/page/rpo-portal> developed by the Commission with immediate effect and start discharging assigned functions to them.

8. The State RPO Monitoring Agency/ Agencies shall nominate a nodal officer working at a rank not below the General Manager/ Superintending Engineer for co-ordination in the matter of monitoring, verification and submission of RPO compliance report of obligated entities to the Commission within a period of 10 days from the date of issue of this order.
9. The order dated 21st December 2021 issued by the Commission for designation of State Agency stands withdrawn from the date of issue of this order.
