 - (i) The Respondent No. 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7 and 8 are directed to file their response on the subject petition.
 - (ii) Petitioner and Respondent No. 1, 2 and 3 are directed to file their response on point No. (iii) in Para 2 above.
The aforesaid responses be submitted within two weeks.
4. The matter is fixed for hearing on the **12th November, 2025**.
