Having heard the Petitioner, the petition is admitted for further hearing.

2. Copies of the petition be served upon Respondents within a week by the Petitioner and compliance of service be reported to the Commission. The Respondents are directed to file their responses to the petition within two weeks, thereafter with a copy to the Petitioner. The Petitioner may file rejoinder within a week, thereafter.
3. It is observed that the subject petition is filed invoking provisions under first Amendment to MPERC (Terms & Conditions for determination of Transmission Tariff) (Revision-V), Regulations, 2024. The Petitioner is required to inform the following:
 - i. How the subject Petition comply with these Regulations and justification for filing this Petition in light of Regulation No. 2 of aforementioned Regulations.
 - ii. Compliance with all relevant Clauses of MPERC Capex Guidelines.
 - iii. Why a complete Capex Plan for MYT control period is not filed instead of piecemeal Petitions like P. No. 8/2024 and P. No. 18/2025 filed earlier.
 - iv. Draft public notice on gist of the subject petition in English and Hindi be submitted within a week.
4. The next date of hearing if any, shall be informed to the parties in due course of time.
