Shri Devashish Mathur, Advocate and Mr. Ajay Kumar Shukla, MPUVNL, appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

At the hearing held on 23.07.2025, the learned counsel for petitioner submitted that as directed by the Commission vide daily order dt. 11.06.2025, MPUVNL and MPPMCL have reconciled their differences and reached on a consensus which has been submitted to the Commission. Respondent confirmed that they do not have any objections if the bidding is conducted as per MNRE guidelines. Commission specifically enquired from the Petitioner whether the connectivity of plants is as per MNRE guidelines on which, the Petitioner submitted that the bidding is conducted as per MNRE guidelines and the connectivity of the projects is also at Voltage levels as per MNRE guidelines. After hearing the parties, order is reserved in the matter. Parties may file written submissions in the matter in 10 days.
