Ld. Counsel of the Petitioner submitted that it has filed additional submission in light of the MOEF&CC notification dated 11th July' 2025 which states that Sulphur dioxide emission standards shall not be applicable to all Category 'C' thermal power plants. Petitioner informed that its thermal power plant comes under Category 'C', therefore the norms of Sulphur dioxide emission standards is not applicable on its power station.

2. Ld. Counsel of Respondent No. 1 sought 10 days' time for filing response on the additional submission filed by the Petitioner.

3. Considering the request, Respondent No. 1 is allowed to file its response on the additional submission filed by the Petitioner. A copy of the response be served to the Petitioner simultaneously. Petitioner may file reply on the aforesaid response within 07 days, thereafter.
