3. Section 63 of the Electricity Act, 2003 provides that “Notwithstanding anything contained in Section 62, the appropriate Commission shall adopt the tariff if such tariff has been determined through transparent process of bidding in accordance with the guidelines issued by the Central Government”.

In view of the above, the petitioner and respondents are directed to submit the following information in soft and hard copies within two weeks:

- i. Details and supporting documents of demonstrate that the tariff in the submit matter has been determined through a transparent process of bidding as per Section 63 of the Electricity Act, 2003.
  - ii. Confirm on Affidavit that there has been no deviation from the standard bidding documents issued by the Central Government in this matter.
  - iii. Copy of accepted letter of intent.
  - iv. Detailed information indicating that all relevant provisions of the following guidelines dated 10.08.2021 issued by Government of India, Ministry of Power under Section 63 of the Electricity Act, 2003 have been complied in this matter.
    - (a) Tariff based Competitive Bidding Guidelines for Transmission Service and
    - (b) Guidelines for Encouraging Competition in Development of Transmission Projects.
