Sub: Application under Section 14, 15 and 86(1)(d) of the Electricity Act, 2003 read with Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Procedure of Application for License) Regulations, 2004, with respect to Grant of Transmission License to Mahan Transmission Limited.

Shri Prashant Kumar appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Petitioner stated that they have served copy of petition to respondents in compliance of daily order dated 28.05.2025. Notice was published as required under section 15(2) of the Electricity Act, 2003 and no objections were received. Further, through affidavit dated 04.07.2025, petitioner has submitted that the project doesn't pass through any area mentioned in Section 15(2)(ii) of the Electricity Act, 2003 and that they have written letter to Web Master, Indian Army for issue of NOC however no response has been received from them till date.

2. Ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of respondents no. 1 to 4 stated that they do not have any objections of issue of license to the petitioner as per rules and regulations.

3. Respondent no. 6 also stated that they have no objections in grant of transmission license to petitioner and that they have submitted their response through affidavit dated 24.06.2025.

4. The Commission has observed that Section 15(5) of the Electricity Act, 2003 stipulates as under: -

"Section 15 (5)- Before granting a licence under section 14, the Appropriate Commission shall:

(a) publish a notice in two such daily newspapers, as that Commission may consider necessary, stating the name and address of the person to whom it proposes to issue the licence;

(b) consider all suggestions or objections and the recommendations, if any, of the Central Transmission Utility or State Transmission Utility, as the case may be."

5. The Commission also observed that regulation 1.25 of the MPERC (Procedure of Application for License) Regulations, 2004 provides that the Commission shall also publish a notice in two such daily newspapers, as the Commission may consider necessary, stating the name and address of the person to whom it proposes to issue the license.

6. In view of the provisions of section 15(5)(a) of the Electricity Act, 2003 and regulation 1.25 of the MPERC (Procedure of Application for License) Regulations, 2004, the Commission Secretary is directed to publish notice in daily newspapers. The case shall be fixed for public hearing thereafter.
