Korba Power Limited has filed the subject petition under Section 64(5) of the Electricity Act, 2003. The Commission observes that the parties namely seller, trader and buyer have to first agree to the contents of the petition and then they have to come jointly before the Commission seeking determination of tariff under the provision of the Act. In the subject matter, the petition is signed by petitioner No. 1 namely, Korba Power Limited and requisite fee as per Regulations has also been paid by them. While PTC India Limited has paid requisite fee as a co-petitioner, they are yet to sign the petition.

2. During the motion hearing, Counsel for MPPMCL, buyer in this case, submitted that the petition has not been seen by them and that they are a necessary party in the matter and therefore, they may also be heard.
3. As observed above, all parties namely Korba Power Limited, PTC India Limited and MPPMCL have to come jointly before the Commission for determination of tariff under Section 64(5) of the Electricity Act, 2003. Therefore, a copy of the petition be made available to MPPMCL and then they should sign the petition and deposit the petition fee as per Regulations.
