Shri Harpreet Singh Gupta, Advocate, Shri Ravi Choubey, CGM and Shri Pradeep Chauhan, SE (City) appeared on behalf of the Central Discom.

Shri Khushiya Shivwanshi, SE, Chhindwara, Shri Neelabh Shrivastava, SE, Narsinghpur, and Shri Ravi Kurme, EE, Balaghat, appeared on behalf of the East Discom.

Shri Suresh Chandra Verma, ACE appeared on behalf of West Discom.

Shri Rajesh Patidar, SE and Md. Imran EE, appeared on behalf of the office of Chief Electrical Inspector, GoMP.

At the last hearing held on 12/11/2025, the Commission had directed that Electrical Safety Officers appointed by the Discoms should apprise the Commission about the status of compliance along with the remedial/preventive measures taken in the matter.

At the hearing held on 16.12.2025, the Commission has observed following :-

- (i) Vide letter dated 15/12/2025, Central Discom has submitted its reply;
- (ii) Vide letter dated 01/12/2025, East Discom has submitted its reply;
- (iii) Vide letter dated 12/12/2025, West Discom has submitted its reply.

2. Heard the parties on various safety measures taken by them in compliance with the provisions of the CEA (Measures Relating to Safety and Electricity Supply) Regulations, 2023 notified by CEA and the MP Electricity Distribution Code, 2024. The Commission observed that the status of compliance reported by the DISCOMs is not satisfactory and deficient on various aspects. Ld. Advocate appeared for Respondent No.1 (Central Discom) has sought 15 days' time to report the compliance.

3. The Commission has directed the DISCOMs to submit a comprehensive compliance report on all mandatory provisions under CEA (Measures Relating to Safety and Electricity Supply) Regulations, 2023 notified by CEA and Madhya Pradesh Electricity Distribution Code, 2024, as referred to in paras 3 and 9 of the notice under the subject SMP No. 113/2025, within three weeks from the date of this order. The Commission again emphasized on appointing/nomination of Electrical safety Officer in each Distribution Company.

4. The Electrical Safety Officer appointed/nominated by each Discom shall be required to present the aforesaid compliance report before the Commission on 19<sup>th</sup> January 2026 at 14:30 Hrs in the office of the Commission.

Next hearing in this matter if required shall be communicated after the aforesaid presentation.
