M/s Jhabua Power Ltd. has filed the subject petition under Section 62 and Section 86(1)(a) of the Electricity Act, 2003, read with the MPERC (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Generation Tariff) Regulations, 2020 for True up of Tariff from 1st April, 2022 till 4th September, 2022.

2. Having heard the petitioner, the petition is admitted.

Subject: Petition under Section 62 and Section 86(1)(a) of the Electricity Act, 2003, read with the MPERC (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Generation Tariff) Regulations, 2020 ("MPERC Tariff Regulations, 2020") for True up of Tariff for FY 2022-23 till 4thSeptember' 2022 and extension of cut-off date till 05.07.2024 in respect of 1x600 MW Seoni Thermal Power Station at Barela Gorakhpur Distt. Seoni Madhya Pradesh.

3. Representative of M/s Jhabua Power Ltd. (A joint Venture of NTPC Limited) was also present at the hearing and he submitted that from 05th September,2022 onward, after taking over the ownership by NTPC Ltd., the Jhabua Power Ltd. became Central Generating Station. As such for the balance period, i.e. from 05th September, 2022 to 31st March, 2023, true-up petition shall be filed before Hon'ble CERC under Section 79(1) (a) of the Electricity Act, 2003.
4. The petitioner is directed to serve copy of petition to respondents within seven days and report compliance of service to the Commission. The respondents are directed to file their responses to the petition within 15 days, thereafter. A copy of aforesaid responses be served to the petitioner simultaneously. The petitioner may file rejoinder within a week, thereafter.
5. The information gaps along with additional details/documents which may be required for determination of tariff shall be communicated to the petitioner shortly.
6. Draft Public notice containing gist of the petition in Hindi and English version be also submitted by the petitioner within a week.

The next date of hearing, if required, shall be informed to the parties.
