Shri Yash Vidyarthi, Advocate appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

The Petitioner has filed the subject petition under Section 62 and 86 (1)(a), (b) of the Electricity Act, 2003, read with Regulations 45(1) of the MPERC (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2016 and Regulation 3.6 and 19 of the MPERC (Cogeneration and Generation of Electricity from Renewable Energy Sources of Energy) (Revision-II) Regulations, 2021.

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2. At the motion hearing held on 18.07.2023, Petitioner reiterated the prayers made in the Petition. After hearing prayer, Commission observed that the request of some of the Generators under PM Kusum A Scheme to allow them compensation on account of change in law event was accepted vide order dated 30.12.2022 in Petitions No. 55, 56, 57, 58, 59 and 60 of 2022 and the Petitioner in the instant case was directed to approach Commission for approval of quantum of change in law compensation and mechanism for passing the approved compensation. Petitioner has however approached us with the prayer for redetermination of ceiling tariff under PM Kusum A component.
3. In view of above, at this stage, it would be appropriate to hear Respondents first before taking a view on admissibility issue. Petitioner is directed to serve copy of Petition to the Respondents immediately. Respondents are directed to file their response within 15 days of receipt of notice from Petitioner.

The case will be listed for admissibility separately.
