In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 181(1) read with Section 43(1), Section 44, Section 45, Section 46, Section 47, Section 48 (b), Section 50, Section 56, Section 181(2)(w), Section 181(2)(x) of the Electricity Act 2003 (No. 36 of 2003) and Section 9(j) of Madhya Pradesh Vidyut Sudhar Adhiniyam, 2000 (No. 4 of 2001), and all other powers enabling in that behalf, Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the following amendment in the Madhya Pradesh Electricity Supply Code, 2021 (No. RG- 1(II) of 2021) herein after referred to as the '**Principal Code**' namely: -

SIXTH AMENDMENT TO MADHYA PRADESH ELECTRICITY SUPPLY CODE, 2021

1. Short Title and Commencement-

- 1.1. This Code shall be called "**Madhya Pradesh Electricity Supply Code 2021 (Sixth Amendment) [ARG-1(II)(vi) of 2026]**".
- 1.2. This Code shall come into force from the date of its publication in the official Gazette of Government of Madhya Pradesh.

2. Amendment to Chapter 6 of the Principal Code:

2.1. Regulation 6.1 of the Principal Code shall be substituted by the following, namely:

"6.1 For the protection of the consumer and the public in general, it is necessary that the wiring on the consumer's premises should conform to CEA (Measures relating to safety & electricity supply) Regulations, 2023 as amended from time to time and other safety rules and be carried out by a Licensed Electrical Contractor. The materials used for wiring shall conform to the relevant specifications of the Bureau of Indian Standards or its equivalent. Wherever applicable, the materials used shall bear ISI mark. As soon as the consumer's installation is completed in all respects and tested by the consumer's contractor, the consumer should submit to the licensee, the contractor's test report. The test report form for this purpose shall be submitted to the local office of the licensee:

Provided that for Low Tension category of consumers having connected load up to 150 kW other than those notified by the Government of Madhya Pradesh the licensee shall accept from such consumers a self-declaration form as notified by the Government of Madhya Pradesh in lieu of test report."

3. Amendment to Chapter 8 of the Principal Code:

3.1. Regulation 8.47 of the Principal Code shall be substituted by the following, namely:

“8.47 The bill shall be delivered to all consumers by hand or post or courier or e-mail or any other electronic mode at least ten days prior to the due date of payment.”

4. Amendment to Chapter 9 of the Principal Code:

4.1. Regulation 9.4 of the Principal Code shall be substituted by the following, namely:

“9.4 The due date of payment shall normally be fifteen days for LT agriculture consumers and ten days for all other consumers, from the date of issue of bill. If due date of payment mentioned in the bill is a public holiday, the succeeding working day shall be treated as the due date.”
