2. During the course of last hearing, the Commission directed the Respondents to finalise the agreement and comments in the matter be submitted within three days of the order with a view to avoid further delay in giving credit of wheeled power to the industrial units of the petitioner.

During the course of hearing today, the officer present on behalf the respondents informed that the agreement has been finalized and all taxes and duties prevailing at the time of the agreement shall be applicable. An application should be submitted to the Nodal Officer within three days as directed earlier during the course of hearing on 06.06.06. Petitioner agrees upon the same.

4. The Commission directs the Respondents that a copy of the revised agreement be submitted within thirty days of this order and further needful action be taken in giving credit to the industrial units of the Petitioner. Since there is no further issue pending, with the directions aforesaid, the Commission decides to close the petition.
