- 2. The petition was listed for motion hearing on 05.06.2018.
- 3. During the motion hearing, the petitioner restated the contents of the petition. The petitioner has prayed as under:
 - (i) Direct MPPKVVCL to reduce contract demand from 7000 KVA to 5000 KVA with effect from May 2018.
- 4. The Commission observed that the petition has been filed under the Clause 11.14 (Power to remove difficulties) of the M.P. Electricity Supply Code, 2013,. Annexure 2 of the petition shows that the petitioner had reduced contract demand from 7400 KVA to 7000 KVA and signed supplementary HT Agreement on 08.09.2017. Clause 7.13 of the Code provides as under:

"After the expiry of the initial period of agreement, the consumer will be entitled to reduce contract demand of his connection limited to the minimum contract demand for a particular voltage class as specified in this Code and such request when made to licensee shall come into effect from the date of completion of formalities such as execution agreement etc. Any subsequent request for reduction in contract demand can also be made to the licensee after expiry of at least one year from the date of effect of such reduction in contract demand."
