ORDER (Passed on this day 24th August, 2004)

Shri D.K. Mundra, Dy.General Manager (Commercial) appears for the petitioner.

Shri C.K.Dixit, Additional S.E. appears for the respondent Board.

- 2. The petition is in the matter of grant of permission for changing point of consumption of power from M/s Hind Syntex Ltd, Birgod unit, Dewas to their unit Hind Spinners, Dist. Rajgarh.
- 3. During the last hearing the Commission desired to know from the Board the details of quantum of wheeling charges and whether GoMP would continue to provide 4% or whatsoever amount of subsidy to the Board or not. Commission directed the Board to confirm in writing the technical feasibility and to confirm whether the subsidy given by the Government will be extended. The Commission further directed the Board to inform what are the wheeling charges and the basis of its calculation and how much of it will be subsidized by the Government.
- 4. The respondent Board in its reply today submits that the CMD (WZ) M.P.Paschim Kshetra Vidyut Vitaran Co. Ltd., Indore has requested and submitted to the Board vide ref. dated 2.7.2004 for calculation of wheeling charges and its basis because it is policy matter and to be decided by the Board for the entire State. The respondent Board requests the Commission to grant some more time for submission of calculation of wheeling and its basis to the Commission.
- 5. During the hearing today the Commission enquired from the representative of the Board that whether they will levy wheeling charges on the basis of existing policy till the wheeling charges are calculated by them. Commission further enquired whether the petitioner company and M/s Hind Spinners Ltd. are same entities.
- 6. The petitioner submitted during the hearing that the petitioner Company and M/s Hind Syntex Ltd. file separate Income Tax returns. It shows that M/s Hind Syntex Ltd. and M/s Hind Spinners Ltd. are two different legal entitities.
- 7. Commission directs the petitioner to give an undertaking stating that they are willing to accept the wheeling charges and cross subsidy that will be decided by the Commission and till then wheeling charges at the existing rate of 2% will be levied on the petitioner and subject to subsidy of 4% provided by the State Government. Whatever the cross subsidy finally approved by the Commission will be acceptable to the petitioner.
- 8. Commission heard both the parties and having considered the facts of the case, the Commission grants permission for change of point of consumption from M/s Hind Syntex Limited, Distt. Dewas to their Unit Hind Spinners, Division of Hind Syntex Limited, Distt. Rajgarh in respect of power generated from two Wind Electric Generators of 225 KW each. Further the Commission provisionally grants permission to the respondent Board to allow wheeling of power to the petitioner at the existing rate of 2% wheeling charges till its revision by the Commission and also subject to the following conditions:-
- i) The petitioner should submit an undertaking as aforesaid.
- ii) The technical and other commercial matters should be settled between the Board and the petitioner.
- iii) The supply and sale of power shall be governed by the policy of the State Government and other provisions of law to be made applicable from time to time and also as per terms and conditions of the PPA executed by the petitioner with the MPSEB.
- iv) The petitioner shall comply with the provisions of the Madhya Pradesh Vidyut Sudhar Adhiniyam 2000, and other laws applicable, the Regulation of the Commission, Technical Codes, Standards of Performance or any other quidelines issued by the Commission from time to time.
- v) The petitioner shall furnish to the Commission such information required for the purpose of the discharge of the functions of the Commission, as the Commission may require from time to time.
- vi) The Commission shall be entitled to impose any other conditions as the Commission considers appropriate from time to time, including the terms of revocation or modification of the approval.

Ordered accordingly.
