Sub: In the matter of review of tariff order dated 30.3.07 for X-Ray Plant

ORDER
(Petition No. 49/07)

2. During the hearing on 22.9.07, the representatives of the petitioner have submitted that as the X-ray plant does not consume more units because it is operated for fraction of a second, it is not justified to fix the minimum monthly consumption @ 30 units per KW. They have also contended that the increment in the tariff should be on a rational basis and the Commission has already fixed additional amount to be paid monthly by the X-ray plant in addition to charges for units consumed during the month. The representatives of the Discom made a request to continue with the provisions made in the tariff order.

3. Having heard both the parties, the Commission is of the view that the petitioner has submitted new fact before the Commission that the X-ray plant is operated for fraction of a second and hence the consumption of energy will be very less. The Commission, therefore, directs to admit the petition for review and modify tariff for X-Ray plant under Non-domestic category as under w.e.f. the date of applicability of tariff order dated 30.3.07.

4. The Commission further directs that any excess payment, if received, from consumer on account of above modification be adjusted in next three monthly billing cycles.

5. With the above directions, the petition no. 49/07 stands disposed off.
