

Sub: Extension of control period for the tariff order dated 01.04.2013 for procurement of power from Bagasse based cogeneration power projects in Madhya Pradesh

ORDER

(Date of order: 18th April,2016)

The Commission had passed tariff order on 01.04.2013 for procurement of power from Bagasse based cogeneration plants in Madhya Pradesh for the control period up to 31.03.2016. Since then there has not been much investment in this sector in the state.

2. Looking to the new developments in the aforesaid field, the Commission decides to initiate the process for determination of tariff for the next control period and to extend the existing control period till the new tariff order is issued. All other terms and conditions of the tariff order dated 01.04.2013 shall remain unchanged.

ORDER

(Date of order: 4th May,2017)

The Commission had passed a tariff order on 01.04.2013 for procurement of power from Bagasse based cogeneration plants in Madhya Pradesh for the control period up to 31.03.2016.

2. By order dated 18.04.2016, the Commission had decided to extend the existing control period till the new tariff order is issued. All other terms and conditions of the tariff order dated 01.04.2013 remained unchanged. The Commission also initiated the process for determination of tariff for the next control period.

3. The Sugar Mills Association Madhya Pradesh filed a petition no. OP No. 02 of 2016 before the Hon'ble APTEL. By order dated 01.03.2017 (received on 14.03.2017), the Hon'ble APTEL passed the following order:

“ As per order dated 18.04.2016 passed by the State Commission, it has initiated the process for determination of tariff for the next control period. The State Commission is directed to complete the said process in the light of the said order and determine the tariff as expeditiously as possible and at any rate within a period of two months from the date of receipt of this order by it.”

4. Pursuant to the aforesaid directions of the Hon'ble APTEL, the Commission after considering the aforesaid matter decides as below:

“ Due to non-availability of sufficient data before the Commission, the proceedings of the SMP-51/2016 may be dropped and the control period of the earlier tariff order dated 01.04.2013 which was earlier extended vide order dated 18.04.2016 shall remain enforced till 31.03.2018.”
