ORDER

(Passed on this day 19th October, 2004)

Shri B.K.Dubey, Advocate appears for the petitioner.

Shri C.K.Dixit, Additional S.E. appears for the Respondent Board.

2. The petition is in the matter of establishment of WEG, for captive consumption, and for wheeling of power to be generated from Wind Electric Generator (WEG) upto 1.25 MW.

3. During the last hearing Commission directed the Board that a philosophy paper be submitted. This philosophy paper has been submitted provisionally before the Commission and shall be submitted finally after Board's approval with modification based on the approval of the Board. Commission allows time to the petitioner to submit its comment on the next date.

4. As the representative of the Board today submitted the philosophy paper provisionally without obtaining Board's approval, Commission directs the Board to submit a separate petition alongwith the philosophy paper approved by the Board within a month, so that wheeling charges could be decided finally.

5. During the hearing the Commission queried as to why the charges are not being calculated on the basis of distance, and what is the basis to distribute the wheeling charges between the three Discoms.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case Commission confirms that the order passed on 18.8.2004 vide which provisional permission was granted to the petitioner to allow wheeling of power through Board's grid from the captive generation plant of 1.25 MW of petitioner on the condition of payment of wheeling charges as per the existing captive power policy of the State Government for five years from the date of this order subject to revision to be made by the Commission, will persist. Commission also grants permission to the petitioner to supply surplus power, if any, to the Board @ Rs.2.25 per unit as per the Government policy till the disposal of the review petition (No.104/2004) which is pending before the Commission. The above permission is subject to the following other conditions:-

- i. The technical and other commercial matters should be settled between the Board and the petitioner.
- ii. The supply and sale of power shall be governed by the policy of the State Government and other provisions of law to be made applicable from time to time and also as per terms and conditions of the PPA executed by the petitioner with the MPSEB.
- iii. The petitioner shall comply with the provisions of the Madhya Pradesh Vidyut Sudhar Adhinyam 2000, and other laws applicable, the Regulation of the Commission, Technical Codes, Standards of Performance or any other guidelines issued by the Commission from time to time.
- iv. The petitioner shall furnish to the Commission such information required for the purpose of the discharge of the functions of the Commission, as the Commission may require from

time to time.

- v. The Commission shall be entitled to impose any other conditions as the Commission considers appropriate from time to time, including the terms of revocation or modification of the approval.

Ordered accordingly.
