ORDER

(Passed on this day 25th January, 2005)

Shri C.K. Dixit, Additional S.E., Dewas appears on behalf of the Board.

Shri B.K. Dubey, Advocate appears on behalf of the Petitioner.

Petitioner is a company engaged in the business of extraction and refining of Soybean oil at Narsinghpur and is wheeling power 2.5 MW capacity through the lines of MPSEB to its factory at Narsinghpur vide Commission's Order dated 19.10.2004 in petition No. 70/04. The petitioner submits to the Commission to grant permission for wheeling of its surplus power generated through its other Industrial units located at Village Dobhi, Distt. Mandla, and at Dewas Maks Road, Distt. Dewas for captive consumption. Petitioner has submitted its Annual Report for 2003-04 indicating that the industries at Mandla and Dewas belong to the petitioner.

The Respondent Board submits to the Commission that the petitioner has installed 1 No. WEG of 1.25 MW capacity again with permission of the Commission for 2.5 MW. The representative of the Board states that the MPSEB has no difficulty in providing to all the three units of the petitioner on the conditions vide Commission's order in petition No. 70/04 along with the additional conditions that only a fixed percentage/ ratio of electricity generated will be used by Pithampur and Mandideep plant for a month-wise schedule of generated electricity for wheeling to the petitioners Pithampur and Mandideep plant before the de-commissioning of WEG through a registered letter should be submitted.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case Commission grants permission to the petitioner to wheel surplus power from its unit at Pithampur and Mandideep plant besides its factory at Narsinghpur on the condition of payment of wheeling charges. The existing captive power policy of the State Government for five years from the date of this order subject to revision to be made by the Commission, will persist. The monthly schedule of fixed percentage to be wheeled to Pithampur, Mandideep and their Narsinghpur factory be intimated to the Board in advance, for proper adjustment of wheeled energy by the respective accounting units of the Board. Commission also directs that in the event of any one unit out of the three getting closed the Board will not have any problem in adjusting the supply to the remaining two units. The above permission is subject to the following other conditions:-

- i) The technical and other commercial matters should be settled between the Board and the petitioner.
- ii) The supply and sale of power shall be governed by the policy of the State Government and other provisions of law made applicable from time to time and also as per terms and conditions of the PPA executed by the petitioner with MPSEB.
- iii) The petitioner shall comply with the provisions of the Madhya Pradesh Vidyut Sudhar Adhiniyam 2000, Electricity Act 2003 and other laws applicable, the Regulation of the Commission, Technical Codes, Standards of Performance or any guidelines issued by the Commission from time to time.
- iv) The petitioner shall furnish to the Commission such information required for the purpose of the discharge of the functions of the Commission, as the Commission may require from time to time.
- v) The Commission shall be entitled to impose any other conditions as the Commission considers appropriate from time to time, including the terms of revocation or modification of the approval.

Therefore, in view of aforesaid, the Commission decides to close the case.

Ordered accordingly.
