Provided that if the licensee is satisfied that there are sufficient grounds for deviation in the norms above stated and such deviation is technically feasible, it may grant the same for reasons to be recorded in writing."

5. The Commission is of the opinion that in terms of the aforesaid proviso to the clause 3.4 of the M.P. Electricity Supply Code, 2013, the Distribution Licensee may take suitable action to take up the aforesaid issue raised by the consumers. Under the aforesaid circumstances, the Commission does not find it appropriate for any amendment to clause 3.4 of the M.P. Electricity Supply Code, 2013. In view of the above, the petition no. 44 of 2018 stands disposed of.
