

**Sub: In the matter of petition under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 for non-compliance by MPMKVVCL, Bhopal of the directions passed by MPERC, Bhopal**

Shri M.L. Nikarwar, DGM appeared on behalf of the respondent.

2. By letter dated 28.03.2018, M/s Narmada Equipment Pvt. Ltd. Govindpura, Bhopal had requested the Commission to take action against M. P. Madhya Kshetra Vidyut Vitaran Co. Ltd. (MPMKVVCL) Bhopal for non-compliance of the order dated 13.02.2013 of the Appellate Authority. The Commission vide letter No. 604 dated 07.05.2018 forwarded a copy of the consumer's letter to MPMKVVCL and directed to submit its response within 15 days. The reply was not received by the Commission. By letter No. 753 dated 30.05.2018, the Commission directed MPMKVVCL to submit its response within 10 days. MPMKVVCL had not submitted its response in the matter. By letter No. 892 dated 27.06.2018, the Commission again directed MPMKVVCL to submit its response within 10 days. MPMKVVCL had still not submitted any response.

3. Due to non-compliance of the aforesaid directions of the Commission, it was decided to register this Suo-Motu petition and the case was listed for hearing on 28.08.2018.

4. During the hearing on 28.08.2018, the respondent MPMKVVCL has submitted that the aforesaid compliance could not be done due to shortage of staff and transfer of concerned Officers and now the order of the appellate authority has been complied with by revising the bill and allowing credit of excess amount in the bill.

5. Having heard the respondent and on considering its written submission, the Commission has noted that the order of the appellate authority has been complied with by the respondent. The
