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## Petition No. 06/2007

### ORDER

(Passed on this day 05<sup>th</sup> April 2007)

1. Shri Ajay Porwal , consultant Ruchi Soya appeared on behalf of the petitioner.
2. Shri V.K.Pandya SE (PS) O/o CE(PS) MPPTCL Jabalpur and Shri D.K. Ojha S.E. (Comm.) O/o. CMD (WZ) appears on behalf of the Respondent Company. .

3. The petitioner has filed this petition on 21.03.2007 in the matter of establishment of wind electricity generators (WEGs) upto 4 nos. of 0.6 mw. Capacity, 'SUZLON' make in the hills of village Sujapur, tehsil Jaora, District of Ratlam (M.P.)

4. The petitioner prays to the Commission that applicant company be granted permission for wheeling of power through the network grid of the respondent from the site of WEGs for captive consumption in its factory as aforesaid. It is also submitted by the petitioner that the applicant company may kindly be granted permission to use the transmission/ distribution system of the respondents on payment of wheeling charges as decided by the Commission. It is further submitted by the petitioner that the respondents may kindly be directed to purchase the surplus power, if any, from the applicant company at the rate as decided by the Commission.

5. Case is listed for hearing today. Respondents west discom submitted the reply that petitioner M/s Ruchi Soya products have installed 4. nos. WEGs each of capacity 0.6 M.W. at village sujapur tehsil Jaora district. Connectivity to the aforesaid generators has already been provided on 31.03.2007. The Petitioner has installed the above mentioned WEGs for captive use. Open access application should have been submitted by the consumer to the M.P.Power Transmission Company. The respondent no. 1. M.P.Transmission Company has submitted that petitioner may be directed to submit the application to the nodal officer in accordance with the MPERC(Terms and Condition for Intra State Open Access M.P.) regulation 2005 with full details.

6. After hearing both the parties the Commission observes that the petitioner has already been provided connectivity to the grid from the aforesaid WEGs on 31.03.2007. The Commission also directs the petitioner to submit application to the nodal officer as per the provision of the MPERC Regulation mentioned above. The Commission also directs the petitioner to pay 2% wheeling charges as per the State Govt. Policy on non-convention energy. Parties are directed to execute agreement as per approved model agreement sent to West Discom.

7. With the above directions aforesaid the Commission decides to close the case.
