The petitioner has submitted this petition on 06.11.2007 in the matter of payment against sale of Electricity generated by 13 Nos. of 800 KW WEGs installed by various investors in the Wind Farm Project developed by Enercon India Ltd., at Wind Farm site in the State of Madhya Pradesh. The petitioner has filed revised petition on 23.11.2007 including above-mentioned six co-petitioners.


3. The petitioner has submitted that they are engaged in the business of development of Wind farm Projects in the Country, having registered office at Plot No. 33, Daman Patalia Road, Daman. The Enercon (India) Ltd. have already installed 9.6 MW Wind Farm Project at Nagda Hills Distt, Dewas and are also developing 90 MW wind farm projects at Ratedi Hills, Dewas.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and submissions made by the parties the Commission grants permission to the petitioner to connect the grid and to sell the energy generated from the petitioners WEGs mentioned in the para 1 to the M.P. Power Trading Company at the rate decided by the Commission vide order dated 21/11/2007. Further the Commission directs M.P. Power Trading Co. to submit the PPA for approval of the Commission within a week. The permission is subject to the following conditions:

- (i) The supply of power should be governed by provision of the Electricity Act 2003 and the Regulations.
- (ii) The Commission shall be entitled to impose the other terms and conditions as it considers appropriate from time to time.

5. With the directions aforesaid, the petition stands closed.
