- 2. The petitioner has filed the subject petition requesting the Commission for approval of extending rebate to its new HT consumer M/s Vacmet India Ltd., District Dhar under the provisions of Section 61 and 62 of the Electricity Act 2003 and in pursuance of the decision taken by the Cabinet Committee on Investment Promotion , GoMP under chairmanship of Hon'ble Chief Minister, for providing rebate of Rs 1/- per unit in energy charges for 7 years from date of issue of GoMP order dated 14.10.2015
- 3. The Commission determines the tariff in accordance with the provisions under Section 62 of the Electricity Act 2003. The Commission has already provided a Rebate for new HT connections across the State under Tariff Schedule HV3.1 (Industrial) of its Retails Supply Tariff Order for FY 2016-17 issued on 05.04.2016 as below.

**Rebate for new HT connections**: A rebate of Rs. 1/Unit or 20% whichever is less is applicable in energy charges for new HV 3.1 tariff category connection for the monthly consumption recorded. Provided these connections are given to green field projects and no rebate is applicable for new connections obtain by virtue of charge in ownership in existing connection.

4. The instant petition for seeking dispensation to HT consumer M/s. Vacmet India Ltd is not in accordance with the Section 62(3) of the Electricity Act 2003 and is therefore, not maintainable. The petition is therefore, dismissed.
