Shri Manoj Dubey, Advocate, Shri G.L. Pandey, DGM and Shri Gagan Diwan, DGM of the Company appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

2. The petitioner, M.P. Power Management Company Limited has filed this petition under Section 86(1)(e), 61(h) and 62 of the Electricity Act, 2003 seeking approval for compliance of RPO target on overall (Solar+ Non-Solar basis) and approval for excess RPO compliance and carry forward of the same in subsequent years for adjustment against shortfall, if any. In its petition, the petitioner mainly prayed as under:

- (i) Allow compliance of RPO target on overall (Solar+ Non-Solar) basis for FY 2017-18 and onwards;
- (ii) Approval for procurement of excess renewable energy from Solar and Non-Solar RE Sources, over and above RPO targets from FY 2015-16 to 2017-18 and also pass on purchase cost of the same in the ARR True-up proceedings for the respective years;
- (iii) Allow procurement of excess renewable energy from Solar and Non-Solar RE Sources, over and above RPO targets from FY 2015-16 to 2017-18 to be carried forward for fulfillment of RPO for future years, as and when needed.

3. The case was listed for motion hearing on 28.08.2018. During the motion hearing, the petitioner restated the contents of the petition and requested to consider the issues.

4. Having heard the petitioner and on considering the written submissions, the Commission has noted that there is no provision on the aforesaid issues under the MPERC (Cogeneration and Generation of Electricity from Renewable Sources of Energy) (Revision-I) Regulations, 2010. As such, the request of the petitioner is not tenable.

5. In view of the above, the petition no. 36 of 2018 stands disposed of.

Ordered accordingly.
