Sub: In the matter of classification of bill boards, hoardings, neon lamps, Halogen lights as separate category for tariff determination.

- 2. The Commission had directed the Board and Discoms to submit details regarding consum falling under the category for neon signs, hoardings, glow signs, billboards, halogen lights, details consumption and connected load of non domestic consumers having sanctioned load above 10 KW consumption of 1500 units/month or more. They were also directed to submit their comments on feasibility to TOD metering in above and a separate tariff category for the above mentioned segments.
- 3. The Commission has observed that only West Discom has submitted the required informat and the other two Discoms have not yet submitted the same. However, the West Discom have not offe their views on the feasibility of TOD metering in above and a creation of separate tariff category for above mentioned segments.
- 4. The Commission has observed that the connections of neon signs, hoardings etc. forms a p of the non- domestic connected load of the consumer irrespective of the fact that such hoardings are a being utilized for advertising purposes. The West Discom has not been able to furnish information on purpose of use of such sign boards to the Commission.
- 5. The Commission therefore directs that the matter regarding creation of separate tariff for su category of consumers shall be dealt with during determination of retail tariff for FY07.
- 6. In view of the above, the Suo-Motu petition no. **51/2005** stands closed.
