ORDER

(Petition No. 47/07)

Shri P.L.Nene, Consultant appears on behalf of the petitioner. Shri D.K.Ojha, SE appears on behalf of M.P. Pashchim Kshetra Vidyut Vitaran Co. Ltd., Indore (West Diiscom). Shri R.D.Koshta, Addl. EE appears on behalf of M.P. Poorva Kshetra Vidyut Vitaran Co. Ltd., Jabalpur (East Discom).

During the hearing on 24.10.2007, the representatives of the petitioner made a representation that the 2. Khandsari Industry works continuously from 15th November to 15th May and therefore not being considered as working continuously as the period is spread over two financial years. The petitioner has, therefore, requested to consider the following issues :-

The word "continuous" appearing in the applicability clause of tariff schedule HV-4 to be deleted. In the above applicability clause, instead of " six months", the word "one hundred eighty days"

(ii) should be mentioned.

(iii) The actual date of commencement of season may be taken as the date of start of season.

3. The representatives of the Discoms have submitted that billing is being done as per provisions of tariff order dated 30.3.07.

The Commission has noted that the petition is time barred. However, the petition is allowed by the 4. Commission for hearing on 24.10.07.

Having heard both the petitioner and the respondents, the Commission directs that the words "one 5. hundred eighty days continuously from the actual date of commencement of season" be inserted in place of words "six months continuously in a financial year" in the tariff schedule LV-4 of tariff order dated 30.3.07 to obviate the confusion that may arise while implementing the above tariff order by different licensees.

With the above directions, the petition no. 47/07 stands disposed off. 6.
