ORDER

(Passed on this day 19th January, 2005)

Shri S.K. Gujrati, EE (o), O/o SE City Circle, Indore appears on behalf of the Board.
None appears on behalf of Petitioner.

The petition is in the matter of grant of permanent LT connection for the purpose of the civil construction work in Indore city and regarding wrong application of tariff.

The petitioner is engaged in civil construction business and requires LT connection of 10 HP for non-domestic work. The petitioner submitted that the construction period is for more than two years and the Board has denied to provide permanent connection and advised the petitioner to take temporary connection for six months. The petitioner is ready to sign an agreement with the Board and willing to pay the shifting charges as per regulations applicable but would like to have LT permanent connection.

In the last hearing on 15/12/04 the Commission proposed to make amendment in the Supply Code, 2004 and allow temporary LT connection for maximum three years for construction agencies. During the course of hearing today the Board in its reply submits that as the agreement period in permanent IP and CP connections is for 2 years, temporary connection for maximum two years can be provided to the petitioner. Approval from a competent authority is required if the petitioner applies for shifting of connection within 2 years and the shifting charges would be payable as per the orders on Miscellaneous and General Charges issued by the Commission. Today the Petitioner is absent. In view of the Board agreeing to provide temporary connection for construction work upto a period of two years, the Commission directs to make amendment in the M.P. Electricity Supply Code 2004 to provide temporary connection for maximum period of two years specially for construction works. With the direction aforesaid, Commission decides to close the case.

Ordered accordingly.
