Solar Power Developers association has filed the subject petition under sections 86 (1) (b), 86 (1) (e) and 181 of the Electricity Act, 2003 read with Regulation 16 of the MPERC (Co-generation and generation of electricity from renewable sources of energy) Regulations, 2021 (Revision-II) seeking exercise of the Commission's power to amend the aforesaid regulations for incorporating banking provisions in line with the Green Hydrogen Policy issued by the Government of India on 17.02.2022.

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2. Petitioner submitted that earlier the opportunity to present their case at the public hearing held on 11.10.2022 regarding amendments to MPERC (Co-generation and generation of electricity from renewable sources of energy) Regulations, 2021 could not be availed by them and that they had filed written submission subsequently. However, due to pendency of the subject Petition No 69 of 2022, the petitioner did not make all submissions in response to the draft Regulations earlier and that few more submissions are to be presented before the Commission at this stage. The petitioner requested to allow one week time for the written submission.
3. It was decided that petitioner be allowed to file written submission which can be clubbed with the submission made earlier in response to proposed amendment in Regulations 2021 and that the subject petition may not be heard any further and disposed accordingly.
