None appeared on behalf of Respondent No.1 and filed a written submission.

2. The petition is in the matter of permission under Section 86(1)(e) of the Electricity Act, 2003 for wheeling the energy generated from WEGs to the place of consumption for sale to third party and execution of fresh Power Purchase and Wheeling Agreement for the balance period of 8 years for 5 Nos. of WEGs (Location No. 45, 50 to 53 of M/s Cepco Industries Pvt. Ltd.)

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- Sub:- In the matter of permission under Section 86(1)(e) of the Electricity Act, 2003 for wheeling the energy generated from WEGs to the place of consumption for sale to third party and execution of fresh Power Purchase and Wheeling Agreement for the balance period of 8 years for 5 Nos. of WEGs (Location No. 45, 50 to 53 of M/s Cepco Industries Pvt. Ltd.)
- 3. The Petitioner is the owner of 5 Nos. of WEGs each of 225 KW rating installed in the windfarm at Jamgodrani, Dist. Dewas at location No. 45, 50 to 53 (Hill-C). These WEGs were commissioned on 27.05.1998. The electricity generated and produced by these WEGs is consumed by M/s Kataria Wires Ltd., Ratlam. The Company had signed a PPA with the then MPEB for a period of 12 years effective from 27.05.1998. The agreement has expired on 26.05.2010. The Petitioner is willing to continue to sell the energy generated by the above WEGs to M/s Kataria Wires Ltd., Ratlam for the balance period of 8 years. The Petitioner agrees to:
  - (a) Sign a fresh power purchase and wheeling agreement as per the draft approved by the Commission under tariff order dated 21.11.2007 with MP Tradeco.
  - (b) Pay monthly line rent, reactive energy charges, wheeling charges, etc. as per tariff order dated 21.11.2007.
- 4. The Petitioner has therefore prayed to the Commission to grant permission for
  - (a) Wheeling of energy from his above 5 Nos. of WEGs in the windfarm at Jamgodrani, Dist. Dewas to the works of M/s Kataria Wires Ltd., Ratlam through the HT connection provided to the premises.
  - (b) Execution of fresh Power Purchase and Wheeling Agreement for a period of 8 years from 27.05.2010 to 26.05.2018 with MP Power Trading Co.
  - (c) Payment for surplus energy (energy delivered by his WEGs to the grid but not consumed) at the rate of Rs. 2.87/unit as specified in the above tariff order by MP Power Trading Co. Ltd.
- 5. The Respondent No.1 in its written submission requested the Commission to direct the Petitioner to approach the MP Power Trading Co. Ltd. for sale of inadvertent flow of power, if any.
- 6. During the hearing on 22.06.2010, the representative of Respondent No.2 made a submission that the Petitioner may be directed to obtain necessary permission for open access

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for the balance period of 8 years from the date of expiry of the agreement. The representative of Respondent No. 3 submitted that the Commission may issue directives for power purchase agreement with Respondent No. 1 by the Petitioner for their above WEGs w.e.f. 27.05.2010 and inadvertent flow of surplus energy to the grid to be purchased by Respondent No. 1 as per order of the Commission.

- 7. On hearing the Petitioner and the Respondents, the Commission allows the Petitioner to sell energy generated from his WEGs at Location No. 45, 50 to 53 in windfarm at Jamgodrani Dist. Dewas to third party namely M/s Kataria Wires Ltd., Ratlam for the balance period of 8 years w.e.f. 27.05.2010 to 26.05.2018 and also allows to sell the inadvertent flow of energy, if any, to the MP Power Trading Co. Ltd. at the rates determined by the Commission in the tariff order dated 21.11.2007 for procurement of power from WEGs commissioned on or before 11.06.2004 subject to execution of power purchase agreement as approved by the Commission for third party sale. The Petitioner shall also obtain required open access permission from MP Power Transmission Co. Ltd., Jabalpur and shall pay the applicable charges as determined by the Commission. The Commission has further directed that a tripartite agreement among Petitioner and Respondent No. 1 & 3 shall be executed for wheeling of power for 3<sup>rd</sup> party sale and any inadvertent flow.
- 8. With the above directions, the Petition No. 31 of 2010 stands disposed off.
