Power Management Company Ltd. under Section 86 (1) (b) read with the Section 63 of the Electricity Act, 2003, and under para 4.24 of MPERC (Power Purchase and Procurement Process) Regulation 2023 (RG – 19 (II) of 2023) for approval of Transfer and Assignment Agreement dated 12.03.2020 in the name of Mahan Energen Ltd. (MEL) from Pench Thermal Energy (MP) Ltd. (PTEMPL) along with approval of supplementary Triparty agreement.

2. Vide letter dated 15.05.2023, the petitioner has sought permission to withdraw the subject Petition with the following submission:
