- 2. The Petitioner has filed this petition for seeking clarification on aspects related to banking and applicability of Open Access Charges for wheeling of electricity generated from WEGs for captive use or sale to third party.
- 3. During the hearing, the representative of the Petitioner made the following submissions:
  - (i) The Distribution Licensee has not submitted the methodology for banking within stipulated time frame provided in the Tariff Order dated 21.11.2007.
  - (ii) The clarification on the applicable wheeling and open access charges for wheeling of electricity generated from Wind Electric Generators (WEGs) for captive use and third party sale may be issued.

4. During the hearing, the representative of the Respondent made a request to allow three

months' time to submit banking policy.

5. During the hearing, the representative of MP Power Transmission Company Shri Vincent

D'souza, having been allowed to speak, made a submission that wheeling charges shall also

include transmission charges and the Commission vide its Order dated 07.11.2008 in SMP

65/2008 has decided the transmission charges to be recovered.

6. On hearing both the Petitioner and the Respondent, the Commission has directed the

Respondent to submit policy on banking within two months i.e. latest by 15.10.2009. The

Commission has further directed that till the determination of wheeling and open access charges in

respect of non-conventional sources of energy, the same may be recovered provisionally in terms

of Tariff Order dated 21.11.2007.

7. With the above directions, the Petition No. 24/2009 stands disposed off.
