- 2. The petitioners, three Distribution Licensees have filed this petition for amendment in the MPERC (Establishment of Forum and Electricity Ombudsman for redressal of grievances of the consumers) (Revision-I) Regulations, 2009 so as to include limitation of 2 years for filing of complaint before the Electricity Consumer Grievances Redressal Forum. The case was listed for motion hearing on 23.01.2018.
- 3. During the motion hearing on 23.01.2018, the petitioners restated the contents of the petition. The petition was admitted for further hearing and the next date of hearing was fixed for 20.02.2018.
- 4. During the hearing on 20.02.2018, the petitioners stated that the MPERC (Establishment of Forum and Electricity Ombudsman for redressal of grievances of the consumers) (Revision-I) Regulations, 2009 does not provide for any limitation period for filing of complaints by the consumers before the Electricity Consumer Grievances Redressal Forums. The Regulations notified by Gujarat, Andhra Pradesh, Haryana, Telangana, Arunachal Pradesh and Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commissions do have the provisions of such limitation period. The petitioners further requested to provide the similar provisions in the aforesaid Regulations, 2009 also.

Sub: In the matter of petition for amendment in the MPERC (Establishment of Forum and Electricity Ombudsman for redressal of grievances of the consumers) (Revision-I) Regulations, 2009 so as to include limitation of 2 years for filing of complaint before the Electricity Consumer Grievances Redressal Forum

- 5. Having heard the petitioners and on considering their written submissions, the Commission is of the view that in the interest of justice to both the licensees and the consumers and as specified by other Electricity Regulatory Commissions also, there should be a limitation period for filing the complaints by the consumers before the Electricity Consumer Grievances Redressal Forums. The Commission, therefore, directs the Commission Secretary to initiate the necessary amendment in the MPERC (Establishment of Forum and Electricity Ombudsman for redressal of grievances of the consumers) (Revision-I) Regulations, 2009.
- 6. In view of the above directions, the petition no. 54/2017 stands disposed of.
