Sub: In the matter of reduction in contract demand from 5000 kVA to 3500 kVA at 132 kV under the M.P. Electricity Supply Code, 2004

## **ORDER**

Shri A.N. Pandey, Consultant and Shri D.K.Pareek, Sr. GM (Accts.) of the company appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

- 2. The petitioner, M/s Parasrampuria International has filed this petition seeking permanent reduction in contract demand from 5000 kVA to 3500 kVA at 132 kV under clauses 7.9 to 7.14 read with clause 3.4 of the M.P. Electricity Supply Code, 2004.
- 3. The case was listed for motion hearing today.
- 4. During the hearing, the petitioner reiterated the contents of the petition and requested the Commission to consider reduction in the contract demand from 5000 kVA to 3500 kVA at 132 kV.
- 5. Having heard the petitioner and considering its written submissions, the Commission has noted that M.P. Electricity Supply Code, 2004 read with all amendments thereto was repealed by the M.P. Electricity Supply Code, 2013 w.e.f. 30.08.2013. The clause 3.4 of the M.P. Electricity Supply Code, 2013 provides that if the Licensee is satisfied that there are sufficient grounds for deviation in the specified norms and such deviation is technically feasible, it may grant the same for reasons to be recorded in writing. In the instant case, the distribution licensee has considered the request of the petitioner and has not found it feasible to accept as conveyed vide its letter dated 06.01.2015.
- 6. In view of the above, the petition is dismissed.

Ordered accordingly.
