The petition is in the matter of Clause 5.3 of MP Electricity Supply Code, 2004 – modification / clarification thereof.

2. During the last hearing on 22.01.2008, the representative of the Petitioner made a submission that in view of the clarification issued by the ATE vide Order dated 17.12.2007, the Clause 5.3 should be made applicable to dedicated feeder laid after 10.06.2004 and no maintenance charges should be charged from feeders laid before 10.06.2004. During the hearing, the representative of the Discoms stated that the concept of dedicated feeder was there earlier to the provisions made in Supply Code, 2004. The representative of the Respondent No. 3 has submitted the MPSEB's Circular dated 27.06.1996 in this behalf to the Commission.

3. The Commission after hearing the Petitioner and the Respondent had directed that an appeal may be filed before the Appellate Tribunal for Electricity for reviewing its order dated 17.12.2007 in the matter regarding levy of maintenance charges for dedicated feeders laid from time to time. The Commission further directs that till such time the decision is obtained from the Appellate Tribunal for Electricity, this petition may be kept in abeyance.

4. The Commission has decided that since more than two years have elapsed and no review appeal could be filed, the decision of ATE be considered while comprehensive review of Electricity Supply Code is taken up by the Commission.

5. In view of the above, the petition No. 70 of 2007 stands disposed of.
