ORDER

(Passed on this day 13th December, 2005)

Shri B. K. Dubey, Advocate and Shri A. K. Pandey appear on behalf of the petitioner.
Shri C. K. Dixit, Addl. S.E., M.P. Paschim Kshetra Vidyut Vitaran Co. Ltd., Dewas appears for the respondent Board.

2. The petition is in the matter of permission for wheeling of power for captive consumption.
3. The petitioner submits that he is engaged in the business of manufacturing of Menda, Rewa, Suji and Bran and he is HT consumer of the respondent having connection of 600 KVA. The petitioner also submits that he is desirous of installing 0.6 MW WEGs SUZLON for generating electric power for captive use in its factory at village Rehmapur, Indore Road, Khandwa and also for sale of surplus power to respondent. The petitioner also submits that as per the provision of Electricity Act, 2003 and the provision of existing policy of the State Government wheeling of power from the point of generation to any other places for captive use or sale of power will be allowed through MPSEB's transmission/distribution system on payment of 2% wheeling charges. Therefore, the petitioner prays to the Commission that applicant may kindly be granted permission for wheeling of power through network grid of the respondent on payment of 2% wheeling charges. The petitioner further prays to the Commission that respondent may also be directed to purchase the surplus power (if any) from the applicant company @ 2.25 per unit or determined by the MPERC or State Government.
5. The respondent Board submits that they have no objection regarding granting of permission to the petitioner for wheeling of power through the network grid of the respondents from the site of WEG, Suzlon make, for captive consumption in its factory at village Rehmapur, Indore Road, Khandwa.
6. Having heard both parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the Commission grants permission to the respondent to allow wheeling of power to petitioner at village Rehmapur, Indore Road, Khandwa for its own captive consumption for the energy generated from petitioners WEG aforesaid w.e.f date of order commissioning of the generator at the existing rate of 2% wheeling charges till its revision by the Commission and also directed the respondent to purchase the surplus power from the applicant company @ Rs. 2.25 per unit or determined by the MPERC subject to the following other conditions:-
- i) The technical and other commercial matters should be settled between the respondent and the petitioner.
- ii) The wheeling of power shall be governed by the provisions of law to be made applicable from time to time and also as per terms and conditions of the PPA to be executed by the petitioner with the respondent.
- iii) The petitioner shall comply with the provisions of the Madhya Pradesh Vidyut Sudhar Adhiniyam 2000, and other laws applicable, the Regulation of the Commission, Technical Codes, Standards of Performance or any other guidelines issued by the Commission from time to time.
- iv) The petitioner shall furnish to the Commission such information required for the purpose of the discharge of the functions of the Commission, as the Commission may require from time to time.
- v) The Commission shall be entitled to impose any other conditions as the Commission considers appropriate from time to time, including the terms of revocation or modification of the approval.
