- 2. The petition has been filed by the Petitioner in the matter of Section 86(i)(e) of the Electricity Act, 2003 and in the matter of extension of time period of power wheeling agreement executed by the owners of WTGs in respect of 1.25 MW WTGs commissioned for their captive use at Nagda-Palnagar Hills, Tehsil Dewas, District Dewas.
- 3. During the hearing, the Petitioner has prayed that –
 - (i) The order for extension of permission from 5 years to 20 years may kindly be issued.
 - (ii) MP Power Trading Company may be directed to issue the draft supplementary agreement for extension of period of existing PWA/PPA for a further period of 15 years.
 - The Respondent may be directed not to stop the adjustment of generation if the (iii) preparation of draft agreement, execution, etc. takes some time and the expiring of initial period of 5 years comes into force.
- During the hearing, the representative of the Respondent has made the following 4. submissions:
 - The Discoms may be directed to execute wheeling agreement with the Petitioners. (i)
 - The Petitioners may be directed to execute agreements in their new names. (ii)
 - The Petitioners may be directed to submit all relevant documents for verification (iii) and to obtain permission for open access from M.P. Power Transmission Co. Ltd.

- 5. On hearing both the Petitioner and the Respondent, the Commission has directed the Petitioner to submit all the required documents to the Respondent. The Commission has also directed the Petitioner to get the approval for continuation of above agreements within the stipulated time in future. The Commission has further directed the Respondent to follow the procedure required for executing the agreements and there is no need for any specific directions to be issued for routine matters like submission of necessary documents, execution of agreements with the Discoms, etc. The Petitioner also requested that some of his existing agreements are due to expire shortly and hence fresh agreements be in continuance of the existing ones. The Commission directed that new agreement be executed accordingly.
- With the above directions, the Petition No. 37 of 2009 stands disposed off.
