No 1686/MPERC / 2023 -In exercise of powers conferred under Section 181(1)read with Section 39(2)(d), Section 40(c) and Sections 42(2) and 42 (3) of the Electricity Act 2003 (No. 36 of 2003)thereof and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the following Regulations to amend Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission(Terms and Conditions for Intra-State Open Access in Madhya Pradesh)(Revision-I) Regulations, 2021 {RG-24(I) of 2021}herein after referred to as the “Principal Regulations” namely: -

THIRD AMENDMENT TO MADHYA PRADESH ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION (TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR INTRA-STATE OPEN ACCESS IN MADHYA PRADESH) (REVISION-I) REGULATIONS, 2021

1. Short Title and Commencement-

1.1. These Regulations shall be called “Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for Intra-State Open Access in Madhya Pradesh)(Revision-I) Regulations, 2021 (Third Amendment) {ARG-24(I)(iii) of 2023}”.

1.2. These Regulations shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Madhya Pradesh Gazette.

1.3. These Regulations shall extend to the whole of the Madhya Pradesh.

2. Amendment to Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations.

The second proviso of the Regulation 3.3 of the Principal Regulations shall be substituted by the following proviso, namely: -

“Provided further that renewable energy generators and users who have contracted demand or sanctioned load of 100 kilowatt or more, either through single connection or through multiple connections aggregating 100 kilowatt or more located in same electricity division of a Distribution Licensee, shall be provided Open Access, subject to no operational constraints in the Licensee’s system.”

3. Amendment to Regulation 13 of the Principal Regulations.

The 5th proviso to sub-clause (ii) of clause 13B of Regulation 13 shall be substituted by the following proviso, namely: -

“Provided also that additional surcharge shall not be applicable in case of green energy is supplied to the Green Energy Open Access Consumer from offshore wind projects, which are commissioned upto December, 2032.”
