Bhopal, Dated 2nd April 2004

No. 888-ERC-2004. --- In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 55 (2) (f) of the Madhya Pradesh Vidyut Sudhar Adhiniyam, 2000 (No.4 of year 2001) read with section 62 (2) and section 181 (2) (ze) of the Electricity Act 2003 (No. 36 of 2003), the Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the Regulations, namely Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Monitoring of Performance of Licensees and Generating Companies) Regulations, 2004. The Commission shall separately make 'Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Details to be furnished by the Generating Companies and Licensees for determination of tariff) Regulations, 2004' under section 181 (ze, zg) read with section 62(2) and 64 (1) of the Electricity Act, 2003.

<u>MADHYA PRADESH ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION</u> (Monitoring of Performance of Licensees and Generating Companies) <u>REGULATIONS, 2004.</u>

1. Short Title and Commencement

- 1.1. These Regulations shall be called the Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Monitoring of Performance of Licensees and Generating Companies) Regulations, 2004.
- 1.2. These Regulations shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Madhya Pradesh Gazette of the Government of Madhya Pradesh.
- 1.3. These Regulations extend to the whole of the State of Madhya Pradesh and in respect of Distribution licensees, concurrent with the jurisdiction for the supply of electricity by them.

2. Definition

2.1. Unless the context otherwise requires, the words and expressions in these Regulations, shall bear the same meaning as defined in the Madhya Pradesh Vidyut Sudhar Adhiniyam, 2000 (No. 4 of 2001), the Electricity Act, 2003 (No. 36 of 2003), and the Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Conduct of Business) Regulations.

3. Submission of information to the Commission

- 3.1. The Madhya Pradesh State Electricity Board, its successor entities and other electricity utilities are required to submit the information to the Commission in the formats attached.
- 3.2. The periodicity of submission of information is mentioned on each format. For the purpose of this Regulation, a quarter would mean as follows:
 - (a) Quarter 1: April to June
 - (b) Quarter 2: July to September
 - (c) Quarter 3: October to December

- (d) Quarter 4: January to March
- 3.3. The last date of submission of each report shall be 30 days from the end of the period for which the utility will prepare the reports.
- 3.4. Licensee should constitute a working group responsible for monitoring the information and coordination with the Commission for necessary explanations, if any and intimate to the Commission of the working groups.
- 3.5. The Commission may from time to time modify the contents of the formats or add new formats for additional information.
- 3.6. In addition to the hard copies the information shall necessarily be submitted in such electronic form as the Commission may direct or through compact disks or email.
- 3.7. Persistent delay in submission of the information may attract the penalty / fines as per the appropriate provisions of the Act.

4. Use of the Information

4.1. The Commission shall have the right to use the information submitted by Madhya Pradesh State Electricity Board, its successor entities and other electricity utilities as it deems fit including publishing it or placing it on the Commission's website and/ or directing the licensee to display the information in the licensee's website.

5. Savings

- 5.1. Nothing in these Regulations shall be deemed to limit or otherwise affect the inherent power of the Commission to make such orders as may be necessary to meet the ends of justice or to prevent abuses of the process of the Commission.
- 5.2. Nothing in these Regulations shall bar the Commission from adopting in conformity with the provisions of the Act a procedure, which is at variance with any of the provisions of these Regulations, if the Commission, in view of the special circumstances of a matter or class of matters and for reasons to be recorded in writing, deems it necessary or expedient for dealing with such a matter or class of matters.
- 5.3. Nothing in these Regulations shall, expressly or impliedly, bar the Commission dealing with any matter or exercising any power under the Act for which no Regulations have been framed, and the Commission may deal with such matters, powers and functions in a manner it thinks fit
