In exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 181, read with Section 9 of the Electricity Act 2003 (36 of 2003) and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the following amendment in the Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulation Commission (Verification of Generating Plants and Captive Users) Regulations, 2023 (G-45 of 2023) hereinafter referred to as the “Principal Regulations” namely: -

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO MADHYA PRADESH ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION (VERIFICATION OF CAPTIVE GENERATING PLANTS AND CAPTIVE USERS) REGULATIONS, 2023.**

**PREAMBLE**

The Commission has notified Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulation Commission (Verification of Captive Generating Plants and Captive Users) Regulations, 2023 (G-45 of 2023) on 17.03.2023. The Ministry of Power, Government of India has now notified the Electricity (Amendment) Rules, 2026 on 13.03.2026. Certain provisions in the existing Regulations are required to be amended to align these Regulations with the Electricity (Amendment) Rules 2026 notified by the Ministry of Power, Government of India on 13.03.2026. Therefore, these amendments in Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Verification of Captive Generating Plants and Captive Users) Regulations, 2023 (G-45 of 2023) are being made.

**1. Short Title and Commencement**

1.1 These Regulations shall be called the **Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Verification of Captive Generating Plants and Captive Users) Regulations, 2023, Second Amendment (G-45 (ii) of 2026)**”.

1.2 These Regulations shall come into force from the date of their notification in the Official Gazette.

1.3 These Regulations shall extend to the whole of Madhya Pradesh.

**2 Existing Regulation 10 of the Principal Regulations shall be re-numbered as Regulation 11.**

**3 A new Regulation, namely Regulation 10, shall be inserted after Regulation 9 of the Principal Regulations as follows:**

“10. These Regulations and the detailed procedure for verification of status of CGP and captive users, published by the Commission under Regulation 8 of these Regulations, shall be effective till 12.03.2026:

Provided that the designated authority appointed by the Commission under Regulation 5 of the Principal Regulations and “CGP Status Dispute Resolution Committee” constituted by the Commission under Regulation 9 of the Principal Regulations shall remain effective till 31.03.2026:

Provided further that this Regulation will not impact upon pending cases.”
