No. MPERC / 2025/ 424 in exercise of the power conferred by section 39(2)(d), 40(c), 42(2), 42(3) and 86 (1)(e) read with section 181(1) of the Electricity Act 2003, (36 of 2003) and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the following amendments in the Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for Intra-State Open Access in Madhya Pradesh) Regulations, 2021 (Revision-I) {RG-24(1) of 2021} namely: -

**FIFTH AMENDMENT TO MADHYA PRADESH ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION (TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR INTRA-STATE OPEN ACCESS IN MADHYA PRADESH) REGULATIONS, 2021 (REVISION-I)**

**1. Short Title and Commencement-**

- 1.1. These Regulations shall be called **Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for Intra-State Open Access in Madhya Pradesh) Regulations, 2021 (Revision-I) (Fifth Amendment) {ARG-24(1)(v) of 2025}**.
- 1.2. These Regulations shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Madhya Pradesh Gazette.
- 1.3. These Regulations shall extend to the whole of the state of Madhya Pradesh.

**2. Amendment to Regulations 3 of the Principal Regulations.**

A new proviso, namely, 6<sup>th</sup> proviso shall be inserted after 5<sup>th</sup> proviso of the sub clause 3.3 of Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations as under: -

“Provided also that intra state short term open access of energy other than green energy shall not be allowed for transmission and/ or wheeling of electricity to the premises of an obligated entity as defined in Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Cogeneration and Generation of Electricity from Renewable Sources of Energy), (Revision-I), Regulations, 2021 as amended from time to time, if the renewable power purchase obligation for previous financial year has not been complied with by the obligated entity subject to the provisions of Regulation 15 of Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Cogeneration and Generation of Electricity from Renewable Sources of Energy), (Revision-I), Regulations, 2021 as amended from time to time.”
