NOTIFICATION

No. MPERC/2025/1084. In exercise of the powers conferred under Sections 181 (2) (h) and 181(2) (zd) read with Sections 36 and 61 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (No. 36 of 2003) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the following Regulations, to amend the Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Transmission Tariff) (Revision – V) Regulations, 2024, [(RG-28(V) of 2024)]” (hereinafter referred to as “the Principal Regulations”), namely.-

FIRST AMENDMENT TO MADHYA PRADESH ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION (TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR DETERMINATION OF TRANSMISSION TARIFF) (REVISION - V), REGULATIONS, 2024 {ARG-28 (V) (i) OF 2025}.

1. Short Title and Commencement.

- 1.1. These Regulations may be called “First amendment to Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for determination of Transmission Tariff) (Revision -V) Regulations, 2024{ARG-28 (V) (i) of 2025}”.
- 1.2. These Regulations shall come into force with effect from the date of publication in the official Gazette.
- 1.3. These Regulations shall extend to the whole of the state of Madhya Pradesh.

2. Amendment to Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations.

In Regulation 2, “**Scope and extent of application**” of the Principal Regulations, following proviso shall be inserted after first proviso, namely:

“Provided further that exemption from competitive bidding for projects beyond the threshold limit may be considered by the Commission for the following category of projects on the recommendations of State Government and State Transmission Utility:

- (a) Specific category of projects of strategic importance, technical upgradation etc; and
- (b) Projects required to be taken up to cater to an urgent situation.”

3. Amendment to Regulation 27 of the Principal Regulations.

The Regulation 27 shall be substituted by the following Regulation 27, namely:

“27. Lease / Hire Purchase charges / Other Expenses

- (27.1) Lease charges for assets taken on lease by Transmission Licensee shall be considered as per lease agreement provided that the charges are considered reasonable by the Commission.
- (27.2) Payment towards Public Private Partnership Licensee / Optical Ground Wire (OPGW) charges / other charges made by Transmission Licensee shall be considered as per the relevant Order passed by the Commission or CERC or other SERCs. The normative expenses as per the relevant Order or the actual expenses incurred by the Licensee as per the Audited Accounts, whichever is less, shall be allowed after prudence check”.

4. Amendment to Regulation 33 of the Principal Regulations.

The Regulation 33.4 shall be inserted after Regulation 33.3, namely:

- “(33.4) Any other Income shown in the audited accounts, over and above the Tariff and non-Tariff income received by Transmission Licensee shall also be considered as Non-Tariff Income, unless specified otherwise by the Commission”.
