No.1016/MPERC/2026/ -In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 61(h) and 86(1)(e) read with Section 181(1) and Clause (zd) and (zi) of Section 181(2) of the Electricity Act 2003, (36 of 2003) and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission, hereby propose the following Regulations to amend the Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Grid Interactive Renewable Energy Systems Related Matters) Regulations[Revision-II], 2024, {RG-39(II) of 2024}, hereinafter referred to as the **“Principal Regulations”** namely :-

FIRST AMENDMENT TO MADHYA PRADESH ELECTRICITY REGULATORY (GRID INTERACTIVE RENEWABLE ENERGY SYSTEMS RELATED MATTERS) REGULATIONS [REVISION-II], 2024 [ARG-39(II)(i) of 2026]

1. Short Title and Commencement-

- 1.1. These Regulations shall be called **“Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Grid Interactive Renewable Energy Systems Related Matters) Regulations [Revision-II], 2024(First Amendment) [ARG-39(II)(i) of 2026]**.
- 1.2. These Regulations shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Madhya Pradesh Gazette.
- 1.3. These Regulations shall extend to the whole of the State of Madhya Pradesh.

2. Amendment to Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations.

A new Regulation 2(1)(u1) to be added after Regulation 2(1)(u) of the Principal Regulations, namely: -

“2(1) (u1) “PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojna” or “PMSG:MBY” means a scheme launched by Government of India on 29.02.2024.

3. Amendment to Regulation 6 of the Principal Regulations.

3.1 A new proviso, shall be inserted after existing Regulation 6(d) of the Principal Regulations, namely: -

“Provided that prosumers applying for net metering connections under PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojna (PMSG:MBY) shall not be required to pay aforesaid processing fee.”

3.2 A new proviso, shall be inserted after first proviso of existing Regulation 6(i) of the Principal Regulations, namely: -

“Provided further that in case of net metering connections to be served under PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojna (PMSG:MBY), no separate agreement shall be required to be executed. In such case, the agreement shall be appended in the application form itself and shall be executed on-line at the time of application.”

3.3 A new proviso, shall be inserted after existing Regulation 6(j) of the Principal Regulations, namely: -

“Provided that the Licensee shall not charge any fee for testing of meters in net metering connections to be served under PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojna (PMSG:MBY).”

4. Amendment to Regulation 8 of the Principal Regulations.

4.1 Amendment in the Regulation 8A(3)(b) of the Principal Regulations.

Words, numbers and symbols “3(a), 3(b) and 3(c)” appearing in Regulation 8A(3)(b) of the Principal Regulations shall be substituted by words, numbers and symbols “3(a) and 3(b)”

4.2 Amendment in the Regulation 8D(4)(d) of the Principal Regulations.

Words “group net metering agreement” appearing in Regulation 8D(4)(d) of the Principal Regulations shall be substituted by words “virtual net metering agreement”.

5. Amendment to Regulation 9 of the Principal Regulations.

Regulations 9 of the Principal Regulations shall be substituted by a new Regulation 9, as under, namely: -

“9. Renewable Purchase Obligation: -

The quantum of energy generated by the prosumer from the Renewable Energy System under Net Metering, Group Net Metering arrangement, Gross Metering and Virtual Net Metering Arrangement shall qualify towards compliance of Renewable Purchase Obligation (RPO) for the Distribution Licensee:

Provided that in cases Renewable Generation meter is installed as per provisions of CEA (Installation and Operation of Meters) Regulations, 2006 as amended from time to time, and such meter is read by Distribution Licensee, the quantum of energy generated as a whole shall qualify towards compliance of RPO of Distribution Licensee:

Provided further that in case the Distribution Licensee is unable to obtain/measure the units generated by such Renewable Generators, then the generated units shall be considered in accordance with Regulation 3.1 (c) of Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Cogeneration and Generation of Electricity from Renewable Sources of Energy (Revision-II) Regulations 2021 as amended from time to time.”
