No. 343/MPERC/2019 - In exercise of power conferred under section 181(2) (zd) read with Section 61 of the Electricity Act 2003 (No. 36 of 2003), the Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the following amendments in the "Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Transmission Tariff) Regulations, 2016, (Revision-III), [(RG-28 (III) of 2016]" .

First amendment to Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for determination of Transmission Tariff) (Revision-III) Regulations, 2016.

1. Short title and Commencement:

1.1 These Regulations shall be called the "Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for determination of Transmission Tariff) (Revision-III) Regulations, 2016" (First Amendment) [ARG-28(III) (i) of 2019]

1.2 These Regulations shall come in force from the date of their publication in the "Gazette" of the Government of Madhya Pradesh.

1.3 These Regulations shall extend to the whole of State of Madhya Pradesh.

2. Amendment/Addendum: In Regulation 7 of said Regulations, the following is added after sub regulation 7.9 namely:

"7.10 Till notification of Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for determination of Transmission Tariff) Regulations for new control period commencing 1st April' 2019 and determination of tariff by the Commission in accordance with aforesaid Regulations, the transmission licensee shall continue to bill provisionally the beneficiary at the tariff approved by the Commission and applicable as on 31st March' 2019.

Provided that the difference between the tariff to be determined by the Commission in accordance with Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for determination of Transmission Tariff) Regulations for new control period commencing 1st April' 2019 and the above provisional bills raised by the transmission licensee to beneficiary shall be recovered from or refunded to, the beneficiary with simple interest at the rate equal to the bank rate prevailing as on 1st April of the respective year of the tariff period, in six equal monthly installments."
