No. 408-MPERC-2010. In exercise of the powers under Section 181 read with Section 45(3)(b) and 46 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (No. 36 of 2003) and all powers enabling it in that behalf, the Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the following amendments in Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Recovery of expenses and other charges for providing electric line or plant used for the purpose of giving supply) Regulations (Revision-I), 2009 notified on 07.09.2009.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO MADHYA PRADESH ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION (RECOVERY OF EXPENSES AND OTHER CHARGES FOR PROVIDING ELECTRIC LINE OR PLANT USED FOR THE PURPOSE OF GIVING SUPPLY) REGULATIONS (REVISION-I), 2009

1. **Short Title and Commencement:** 1.1 These Regulations may be called the '**Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Recovery of expenses and other charges for providing electric line or plant used for the purpose of giving supply) Regulations, (Revision-I) 2009 (First Amendment) {ARG-31(1)(i) of 2010}**'.
1.2 These Regulations shall extend to the whole of Madhya Pradesh.
1.3 These Regulations shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official gazette of the Government of Madhya Pradesh.
2. **Amendment to the Point No. XV of Annexure-I:**

In the **Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Recovery of expenses and other charges for providing electric line or plant used for the purpose of giving supply) Regulations, (Revision-I) 2009**, the following shall be substituted in point No. XV of Annexure-I namely:-

XV. Registration fee from EHT/HT/LT consumers

The following registration fee is recoverable alongwith application form from a new EHT/HT/LT consumer and also from such existing EHT/HT/LT consumer (who proposes to change his point of supply and/or increase in the contract demand/connected load. The registration fee shall be adjusted on availing of EHT/HT/LT supply by the consumer after deducting cost of the application form. Such fee, however, shall be forfeited if EHT/HT/LT consumer does not avail supply within 180 days or within the stipulated time as per load sanction, whichever is applicable; or cancels the request after load sanction by the Discom.
